



Golden Altos Conflict Minerals Policy

The Dodd–Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act defines several metal ores as “conflict minerals”. The metals derived from these ores include: gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W) and tin (Sn).

As a contract manufacturer, Golden Altos will often procure, for its customers, raw materials which include these metals. These materials are specified by our customers and can often have a single source.

Golden Altos is committed to sourcing responsibly and considers mining activities that feed the conflict as unacceptable.

Regarding conflict minerals, Golden Altos makes all reasonable efforts to align with the work of the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) and Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI). This includes the EICC and GeSI’s Conflict-Free Smelter Program and the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template.

Golden Altos continues to undertake reasonable due diligence within our supply chain to assure that metals under our control and added to the product during our processing are “conflict free”.
